HOW CAN I DESIGN CLOTHES WITH RECYCLED MATERIALS?

Summary

In this project, second-grade students will become eco-fashion designers as they explore how to design clothes using recycled materials. Through hands-on activities, creative design challenges, and English language practice, students will learn about the importance of recycling and sustainability while enhancing their language skills.

Driving Question

How can I design clothes using recycled materials?

- Learn vocabulary and language structures for describing clothes and materials.
- Practice saying what people are wearing bearing in mind the importance of recycling and reusing clothes!
- Connect language with a meaningful purpose.

3. Show your designs to the class and talk about them.
