

# PROJECT IDEA

## HOW CAN WE SPREAD AWARENESS ABOUT ANIMALS' RIGHTS?

### Summary

First, students will learn about animals in general. They will read different texts, watch different videos, and then, they will conduct a research on animals' rights. Finally, they will choose a charity that protects animals and raise money to help them and support them.

### Driving Question

How can we spread awareness about animals' rights? What can we do to help organizations that take care of animals in need?

### Goals

- To use language as an instrument for communication.
- To raise awareness about animals' rights.
- To encourage learners to think about the different ways they can help animals.
- To learn interesting facts about animals.
- To develop learners' speaking skills for fluency.
- To encourage learners to think about the different ways they can help animals.
- To reflect on different issues related to animal exploitation: dog fighting, horse races, circuses, zoos, etc.

### Language Content

- Vocabulary: Farm Animals. Wild Animals. Pets.
- Structures: To Be. Have got. Can.

### Steps

1. Invite people from your organization to speak about animal issues.
2. Think about how you can help.
3. Design a plan.
4. Take action!
5. Teach Your Community About Making a Difference.

### Different Ideas to raise money.

<b>Raffle</b>	You buy a ticket with a number on it. Then someone picks the winning number. If you have the ticket with this number you win the prize.
<b>Bring and Buy Sale</b>	You bring things you want to sell and you buy things at the sale.
<b>Bake Sale</b>	You can buy different baked goods made by students or their parents.
<b>Quiz Show</b>	You pay some money to enter the competition. The winner gets a prize.
<b>Yoga with animals</b>	Provide an animal-themed yoga class.
