





PROJECT IDEA: PODCAST MY ESSAY!



- I. Ask students to write an essay on a topic they are passionate about. Encourage them to choose a specific problem that resonates with them.
- 2. Instruct students to write persuasive essays. These essays should include an introduction, thesis statement, well-structured body paragraphs with supporting evidence, and a conclusion. Emphasize the importance of citing sources properly and crafting a compelling argument.
- 3. Organize peer review sessions where students exchange essays and provide constructive feedback to their classmates. This helps improve their writing and critical thinking skills.
- 4. Ask students to practice reading their essays so that they can be recorded and uploaded in the form of a podcast to the school website/blog.
- 5. Have a podcast festival where students listen to each other podcasts and have meaningful conversations and feeback.



TEACH ARGUMENTATION WITH GAMES!



Let me share with you some games that can boost learners' argumentative and writing skills!

<u>Connect the phrase</u>: Students stand in a circle. Start with a single phrase ending with a transition word, then students take turns building on it and adding another connector. The process is repeated with the next student. This game helps improve sentence fluency and the ability to connect ideas coherently.

<u>Sentence Shuffle</u>: Provide students with a collection of words or phrases related to a particular topic. They have to rearrange these elements to create grammatically correct and coherent sentences or paragraphs. This game reinforces sentence structure and organization.

<u>Brainstorm Balloon Volleyball</u>: Divide students into two teams, each team will choose one person to represent them in the first round. When the game starts, the teacher reads a topic for them to develop. Each time a student hits the balloon, they have to expand on the idea mentioned by the teacher. If a student runs out of ideas, he/she is out of the game.

<u>Jenga</u>: Students are divided into three groups. Taking turns, two of the three teams will be presented with a statement that they will have to argue. One will be the AGREE team and the other will be the DISAGREE team. Each team presents three points to support their argument, and the third team, the JUDGE team, decides which argument is better. The winning team gets to pull a JENGA piece for points. As rounds go on, the teams switch roles, taking turns as AGREE, DISAGREE, or JUDGE. If the JENGA tower falls during their turn, the team loses!"

As the teacher calls out topics, students jot down ideas in the corresponding bingo square. The first to complete three squares shouts BINGO! Students share their ideas.
